A Former Bibby Liner

The Board of Admiralty regrets to announce that the armed merchant cruiser H.M.S. *Salopian* (Captain Sir J. M. Alleyne, Bart., D.S.O., D.S.C., R.N.), has been sunk. The next of kin of casualties have been informed.  
The *Salopian* was formerly the Bibby liner *Shropshire*. She was built by the Fairfield Shipbuilding & Engineering Company, Ltd., in 1926, and had a gross tonnage of 10,549.
