I am in receipt of your letter of the 8th inst. regarding the steering arrangement of the m.v. "ARTHUR TOWN" and have requested the Builders to let me have the desired particulars.

They reported that the vessel is in constant service and that they have advised their Representative Mr. Welch in London to have the matter dealt with as soon as possible in order to avoid further delay.

With regard to the operation of the steering gear from the wheelhouse and the top of the casing, this had been fitted originally, according to their report, and has not been since altered.
