M. I send herewith for your information a copy of a letter which has to-day been addressed to Mr. Robert Welch, of this City, regarding the steering arrangements of the Motor Vessel "ARTHUR TOWN", Messrs. Gebr. van der Werf's Yard No.201, and shall be glad if you will carefully note the contents.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will be so good as to obtain and forward to this Office as early as possible a detail plan shewing the arrangements for operating the steering gear from the wheel house and from the top of the casing. The plan should give full particulars of the gears, the bearings for the shaft, diameter of shafting, the sprocket wheels and chain, and the arrangements for disconnecting the gear on the casing top when this is not required.
