


ARTHURSTOWN.—London, Dec. 2.—At 3.15 p.m. to-day British motor vessel Arthurstown, proceeding up river, struck centre arch of Westminster Bridge damaging paint of iron understructure of bridge. Wheel house signalling lamp on motor vessel damaged; no personal injury.

As the question of this vessel's steering arrangements is still under consideration Mr. Shaw's attention has been called to the above.
