Ltd., LLOYD'S AGENTS, and with the consent of the Master, survey the Tanker "BRITISH CHIVALRY" - 7118 tons gross of London, for the purpose of reporting upon permanent repairs effected to damage stated to have been caused by collision with the vessel "Hopemount", on the 23rd July 1943.

The following repairs have now been satisfactorily carried out, in way of poop superstructure on port side:-

Boat deck, which was set down, released from stanchions, lifted and set in original alignment.

Six angle stanchions, supporting boat deck, renewed.

Damaged water service pipe and guard rails repaired.

These repairs have been satisfactorily completed.
