In March the Committee agreed to a proposal of the Owners to have the General Examination and Boiler Survey carried out on the vessel's return to this country towards the end of that month.

The vessel returned to Bristol but the Surveyors now state she has left again without the outstanding surveys receiving attention.

The Owners state that owing to shortage of labour and the vessel being urgently required, it was not found possible to carry out the surveys as anticipated. It is now proposed that the vessel will be drydocked on her return to the U.K. in about two months' time when all outstanding surveys will be dealt with.
