Vessel has now, ^{left} the district without outstanding surveys receiving attention. The Owners Representative states that owing to shortage of necessary labour & the vessel being urgently required ^{it was not found possible to carry out the surveys as anticipated} on return to the United Kingdom in about two months' time and all outstanding surveys dealt with. Present arrangements are that the vessel will enter dry dock.
