Dear Sir,

We beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 21st.ultimo, enclosing copy of a letter from Snr.Parreira Cruz, in connection with the above vessel.

We understand that most of the transportable items salvaged from this wreck are at Portimão, in the extreme south of Portugal, and to make an examination of all this equipment and machinery would take a minimum of three days away from Lisbon.

Allowing 1.000\$00 per day for the surveyor's absence from the port, the total cost of this visit, including travelling and hotels, would be in the region of £60, which is possibly more than Snr.Parreira Cruz had contemplated as being incidental to obtaining the duplicates. Again it is possible, if not probable, that the marks on the anchors and cables are not decipherable, in which case we should not be able to recommend the issue of a new certificate.

Therefore, before dealing with this case, we think it advisable to inform Snr.Parreira Cruz of the circumstances and request his consent in connection with this visit, and we shall keep you informed of his reply.
