

S.S. "ST. HULE" ex "SALMO"

Stated to have been sabotaged and sunk November 1942.

A wreck stated to be the s.s. "ST. HULE" was seen by the undersigned and Mr. Hildkjaer (Danish Diver) as she lay almost submerged at high tide in the river near Fort Lyantey on 25/10/44.

The ship is stated to have been extensively dynamited and is now so badly broken up that she can only be considered a C.F.I.
