I am in receipt of your letter of the 16th instant enclosing one from Messrs. Cammell Laird & Co.Ltd. regarding the equipment of their Yard Nos. 1053/4, and with regard thereto I have to state that, as no submission has been made to the Committee to dispense with the stream anchor, the Assistant Director of Merchant Shipbuilding and Repairs has been communicated with and he states that, while it has been agreed that the spare anchor shall be dispensed with, it is desired that a stream anchor of the Rule weight and test shall in all cases be supplied, and he is informing the representatives of the tanker Owners, who are seeing that the requirements of the Specification are carried out, to this effect.
