I am in receipt of your letter of the 3rd instant enclosing an endorsement in regard to the omission of the bulkheads in the forward hold of the motor vessel No. 245 to be built by Messrs. Henry Robb, Ltd., and in reply thereto I am directed to state that the Special Survey of the vessel during construction may be proceeded with, but before she is finally classed in the Register Book it will be necessary for a letter to be furnished by the Owners desiring the omission of the bulkhead in question in terms of Section 17, Paragraph 2(c) of the Rules. If this is done, a notation will be made in the Register Book in respect of the bulkheads, namely:-

"Intermediate BH in hold dispensed with, 3BH"
