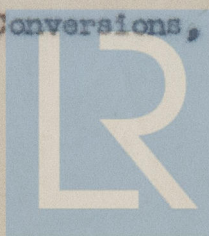
Notification of the assignment of Class of the trawler "ST. ZEMO" will follow as soon as the reports come to hand.
