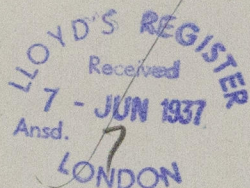

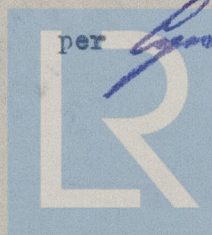
It is stated that the arrangement shown has the Owners' approval. It will be noted that a flat bar is fitted in lieu of the stringer bar.
