I return herewith two copies of the plan, forwarded with your letter of the 15th instant, shewing steel decks for Messrs. Harland & Wolff's Yard No. 1004, and with regard thereto I have to state that provided the arrangements be carried out as shewn and amended and to your satisfaction, they will be approved.

The remaining copy of the plan is being retained for reference.

With reference to the Builders' proposal to fit 10 inch beams at the main deck in way of No.1 hold also 10 inch beams on the shelter deck at the after end of No.2 space in conjunction with the size of girders originally proposed by them, you should inform them that these proposals can be approved, provided a 8 x .60 rider plate be fitted on the shelter deck girders under the bridge front between frames 30 to 36.
