"EMPIRE HARRY" 479 tons gross of Gole, whilst the vessel was lying afloat at Bombay on the 21st March 1944 for the purpose of ascertaining the nature and extent of damage stated to have been caused (1) whilst manoeuvring close to A.F.D. 33 in order to put a harbour tow on board on the 1st March 1944 at 11.40 hours. (2) after slipping the harbour tow and closing with A.F.D. 23 in order to connect a sea tow on the 1st March 1944 at 17.20 hours. Both damages being whilst leaving Bombay.
