We request that the Committee of Lloyd's Register will instruct the Society's Surveyors to Specially Survey during Construction the Hull, Engines and Boilers of the Vessel No. 483 building by Messrs. A.-B. Götaverken for Messrs. Gust. Bull of Sandefjord of 8300 Tons. Length 449'-10" Breadth 59'-0", Depth 35'-6" intended to be Classed +100A1 Carrying Petroleum in Bulk.

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees for the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connection therewith.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:—
