With reference to your letter of the 14th October last, respecting the fees chargeable to the Department of the Controller General of Merchant Shipbuilding in the case of the Steamer "SIRIS" (Greenock first entry report No. 17541), I now enclose for your information a copy of a letter which has to-day been addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Greenock, from which you will see that the fees chargeable in this case are £19 for the survey of the Hull, and £34 for the survey of the Machinery.
