I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 2nd instant respecting the motorship "OAKBANK", the contents of which are noted.

With regard thereto, I have to say that as the General Examination for maintenance of class does not require to be held before the end of April next your proposal to carry out this inspection on the vessel's arrival in this country is in order. As the Load Line Certificate, however, expires on the 31st January next should the vessel experience clearance difficulty on this account arrangements will be made for the Society's Surveyors to visit the vessel with a view to the extension of the Certificate if you will kindly communicate with this Office.

I have to add that the report of the carrying out of the Donkey Boiler Survey has now come to hand from the Society's Surveyors at Sydney, N.S.W. and a record of D.B.S.9,42 has accordingly been assigned.
