With reference to the entry in the Special Reasons List respecting the steamer "INNERTON", I have to acquaint you that in January last the Newcastle Surveyors stated that certain alterations had recently been carried out to the vessel's electrical installation, including the removal of one generator and its replacement by a new one. They added that an opportunity would be afforded for the alterations to be inspected by the Society's Surveyors on the vessel's return to this Country.

The vessel arrived in London recently and the Surveyors state that she is proceeding to your port, where arrangements will be made for the necessary examination to take place.
