


The position as regards vessels built in countries now under German occupation was considered by the Chairmen yesterday, and it was agreed that for the time being the notation "class contemplated" should continue to appear in the Register Book against all those cases in which First Entry Reports had not been received.

As regards those cases in which Reports had been received but payment of fees was in doubt, it was agreed that each case should be considered on its merits. In this category authorisation was given for the posting of the "HORGH SILVERDAWN" and the "SLOTERDIJK" reported from Copenhagen just prior to German occupation, but that no Classification Certificate should be issued without payment of fees.
