H.M. TRAWLER LOST


An official Admiralty communique states that the Board of Admiralty regret to announce that H.M. trawler *Kingston Beryl* (Sub.-Lieut. A. W. J. Baker, R.N.V.R.) has been lost. The next of kin of casualties have been informed.

The *Kingston Beryl* was built at Beverley in 1928. She had a gross tonnage of 356 and was formerly owned by the Kingston Steam Trawling Company, Ltd., Hull.


