I duly received Mr. Crichton's letter of the 28th ultimo regarding the Single Screw Motor Ship No. 300 proposed to be built by the Furness Shipbuilding Co.Ltd., as a duplicate of their Yard No. 283, and with regard thereto I have to state that provided the vessel be built in accordance with the plans approved for the sister ship referred to, the Rules in all other respects be complied with, and the materials and workmanship be to the Society's satisfaction, she will be eligible to be classed 100A1 "Carrying Petroleum in Bulk" with the notation "Longitudinal framing at bottom and at deck".

The plans of No. 283 forwarded with your letter have been endorsed with the new yard number and are being returned to your address to-day under separate cover.
