I duly received Mr. Crichton's letter of the 14th instant enclosing one from the Furness Shipbuilding Co.Ltd., together with plans, in triplicate, of stern frame and rudder for their Yard No. 283, and with regard thereto I have to state that the scantlings and arrangements as shewn and amended on the plans will be approved, provided they be carried out to your satisfaction.

With regard to the communication from the Owners quoted in the Builders' letter, I shall be glad if you will be good enough to explain to the Builders that recent experience has shewn that it is essential that all discontinuities shall be minimised as far as practicable, and that some increase shall be made to the scantlings of the stern frame in the vicinity of the upper gudgeon, and particularly immediately below the counter; the plan has been suitably amended in this respect.

I may add that the Owners' representative has called at this Office and discussed this matter, as arranged.
