I return herewith two copies of the plan, forwarded with your letter of the 8th instant, of Boiler proposed for the above vessel, and have to inform you that this plan will be approved for a working pressure of 180 lb. per square inch, provided two additional stay tubes be fitted as now indicated on the plan and the boiler be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

I have to point out that Section 30, Clause 7, of the Rules for Engines and Boilers requires that nuts should not be fitted to stay tubes at the combustion chamber end.
