I duly received your letter of the 13th instant, with accompanying plans relating to the above contract, and with regard thereto have to inform you that the plan of Fuel Oil Discharge Air Vessel will be approved for a working pressure of 20 lb. per sq. inch, provided the thickness of the bottom end plate be not less than 9/32", the vessel be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing and the welding be to your satisfaction.

Further, the plan of oil fuel storage tank will be approved, provided the tank be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing and the welding be to your satisfaction.
