I am in receipt of your letter of the 24th instant, forwarding one from the Builders regarding the cable run through the centre castle space in the case of the above vessels, together with a plan showing the piping arrangement and the method of ventilating this space.

The plan submitted has been examined, and it is observed that a 12" diameter ventilator in conjunction with a ventilating grill is to be used for ventilating this space. It is considered that this arrangement will provide adequate ventilation for the cables, and I have to inform you that, in these circumstances, the proposed arrangement to run these lead covered, armoured and braided main cables on metal trays will be approved.

I confirm my telegram to you to-day in the matter, as follows:-

"FURNESS 283 AND 300 PROPOSED SUPPORT OF MAIN CABLES IN BRIDGE SPACE APPROVED".
