This vessel, like the sister ship "WOKINGHAM", originally arranged as a C.S.S. vessel with tonnage of 1,000 tons, has now been closed and the draught increased as per endorsement C.S.40 attached to First Entry Report on the "GLASGOW".

Six 'tween deck bulkheads have been fitted over old bulkheads, but the scantlings of the latter have not been increased.

The holds and lower 'tween decks, with the exception of No. 5 hold, have been insulated.


