Dear Sirs,

S. With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steam tugs "Almagro", "PALERMO" and "TIGRE", I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Buenos Aires have forwarded to this office your letter of the 2nd February addressed to them, intimating that you have decided not to continue the classification of these vessels with this Society.

The Committee have had the cases under consideration at their meeting to-day, and I am directed to acquaint you that in the circumstances instructions have been given for the vessels' characters to be withdrawn and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof in each case, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of the vessels' classes, the records of the freeboards assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draughts, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificates are thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
