Dear Sirs,

With reference to your letter of the 8th ultimo respecting the steamer "ANNAGHER", I have to say that the Committee regret to note that you have decided to withdraw this vessel from classification in the Society's Register Book.

I may say that Mr. Lee Annear, the Society's Senior Surveyor at Belfast has reported that he has had an interview with you on the matter, and that so far as this vessel is concerned you do not see your way to alter your intention.

In the circumstances, the Committee, who have had the case before them to-day, have given instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class, the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this office.
