The Special Survey No.2 became due in September, 1931.

On the 11th ultimo, a letter was received from the Owners stating that after discussion it had been decided to withdraw the class of the vessel from the Society's Register Book. They added that it was their intention to increase the number of their vessels at present holding the British Corporation class.

Mr. Lee Annear, the Society's Senior Surveyor at Belfast, has had an interview with Sir. Samuel Kelly in the matter, but was informed that in this case he had definitely decided to class the vessel with the British Corporation.

The case received the consideration of the Classing Committee on Friday, the 5th instant, and in the circumstances it was decided to withdraw the vessel's class from the Register Book and insert three dots (...) in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
