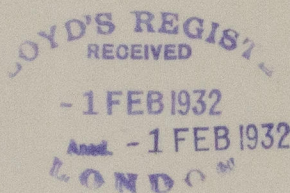

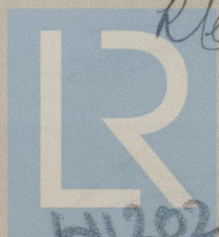
I have pleasure in reporting my recovery from the attack of Gastritis which prevented my projected visit on the 18th instant.
