In cases which have to be submitted to the Classing Committee "the endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/32.)

Survey *Repairs* When due

The class is subject to permanent repairs to damaged stem and stem plating being carried out before the end of July.

In reply to enquiry the Belfast Surveyors write that the Owners wish to postpone the repairs. *& FORWARD A LETTER FROM OWNERS.*

The London Surveyors who examined the damage in June last and made the recommendation now state that, in their opinion, permanent repairs might be deferred until the vessel is submitted to the Special Survey No.2, due 9.31.

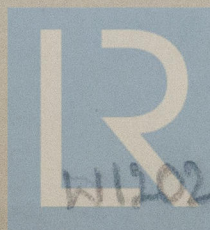
It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey, subject to permanent repairs to stem and stem plating being carried out at the next special survey.
