I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 18th instant respecting the steamer "ATHENDALE" and note what you say with regard to the inquiry you have received from a prospective purchaser of this vessel. In connexion therewith I may say that I have been in communication with Messrs. Thos. Pinkney & Sons who have no objection to your being furnished with the Committee's decision regarding this matter and I have accordingly to inform you that the Committee are unable to agree to the vessel being moved from the Tyne, where she is at present laid up, until the overdue 2nd Special Survey No.1 and all necessary repairs are carried out to the entire satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors.

As you are probably aware the year of grace allowed for the completion of the 2nd Special Survey No.1 expired so long ago as June last year.
