Dear Sirs,

With reference to your letter of the 16th instant respecting the working pressure of the donkey boiler of the steamer "ATHENDALE", I beg to inform you that the pressure as recorded in the Register Book as 100 lb. is correct.

I may add that the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle, where the vessel is at present laid up, have no knowledge of any reduction having been made in the working pressure of this boiler.

I would, however, point out that to complete the Special Survey No.1 on the Machinery, due June, 1929, the survey of the donkey boiler requires to be carried out, and that the main boilers became due for survey last August.
