8. With reference to your report No. 85712 on the machinery of the steamer "ATHENDALE", I have to inform you that in accordance with a request which was received from Messrs. Thos. Pinkney & Sons, enclosing a letter from the National Provincial Bank, Ltd., the Mortgagees in possession of the steamer, they were informed that the vessel was surveyed by you in drydock in May 1930, and a general examination carried out.

I have now received a further letter from them, in which they state that they note that the donkey boiler pressure is given in the Register Book as 100 lb. and that they "hear indirectly that this has been reduced to 90 lb".

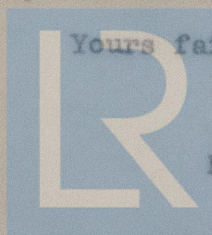
I have therefore to request that you will be good enough to furnish me with any remarks which you may have to offer regarding the point raised by Messrs. Pinkney.
