Reverting to my letter of the 3rd ultimo respecting the steamer "ATHENDALE", I beg to acquaint you that I am receipt of a communication from the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle from which it appears that this vessel is ~~laid~~ up indefinitely and that no steps are being taken with regard to the completion of the Second Special Survey No.1, and Boiler Survey.
