With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "BAN HONG LIONG", I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyor at Singapore has forwarded to this Office your letter of the 24th February, addressed to him, intimating that you have decided to discontinue the classification of this vessel with this Society.

The Committee have had the case under consideration at their meeting to-day, and I am directed to acquaint you that in the circumstances instructions have been given for the vessel's character to be withdrawn and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class, the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
