Dear Sirs,

S. With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "DAIHA MARU NO.1", I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Kobe have forwarded to this Office a translation of the letter you addressed to them on the 19th ultimo, from which it is noted that you have decided to withdraw this vessel from the Society's classification.

In the circumstances the Committee, who have had the case before them at their meeting to-day, have given instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
