I beg to acquaint you that your letter of the 5th instant respecting the steamer "KONINGIN DER NEDERLANDEN" has been forwarded to this Office by the Society's Surveyors at Amsterdam, and to say that the same received the careful consideration of the Committee at their Meeting today.

In reply I have to say that the Committee conclude the offers you refer to have been received from Italian buyers, and on this understanding the Committee will not object to the vessel proceeding in ballast to Italy to be broken up provided the overdue Boiler Survey be carried out and she be submitted to a General Examination and satisfactorily reported upon before she leaves Amsterdam.
