We have received several offers during the past months for "Koningin der Nederlanden" to be sold to a foreign country for breaking up purposes.

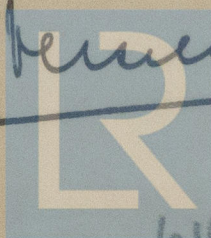
