Orders of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

Endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/32.

The class is subject to two aftermost keel plates being renewed to the Owners' convenience.

The 2nd S.S. No.2 became due 2.31 and in April last the Amsterdam Surveyors were informed that provided the vessel be generally examined and favourably reported upon the Committee would be agreeable to the special survey being carried out some time within the year of grace.

The Amsterdam Surveyors now report that a general examination has been made of the vessel afloat.

The holds, tween decks, engine and boiler space, fore and after peaks, bunkers, decks, hatchways etc., masts, rigging, ventilators, windlass and steering gear have been examined and the tanks partly examined.

In the Surveyors' opinion the general condition of the vessel is good and the Owners' proposal to carry out the special survey some time within the year of grace merits approval.

It is submitted action be deferred.
