The class of this vessel will expire at the end of May 1931, and the late Owners' Executors were communicated with on the 1st instant and informed that to entitle her to be restored to the A character, it would be necessary for the requirements of the survey for restoration (Section 56 of the Rules for Wood Ships) to be complied with, in which case the class could be restored for six years.

A letter has now been received from a Mr. Arthur Ekbohm of Mariehamn, which translated reads as follows:-

"As the class for the above mentioned vessel expires this month, and as she, because of lack of freight is now laid up, we beg to ask that the classification of the vessel may be postponed to next Spring, when we hope that the freight market will be a bit brighter, so that it will again be profitable to put the vessel in commission.
