With reference to the Secretary's letter of the 25th instant, regarding Glasgow Report No. 42585 on the Steamer "DUMANA", I beg to state that two independent sets of rams and cylinders are fitted, operated by separate pumps and motors. It is therefore not necessary to furnish any other independent means of steering. This is in accordance with the Secretary's letter of the 19th May 1920 regarding Messrs. Litngows' S.S. No. 731.

The arrangement has also been approved in the case of the S.S. "DUMANA", the steering gear being made by Messrs. Brown Bros.
