Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that I am in receipt of a cablegram from the Society's Surveyors at Kobe intimating that the steamers "KIFUNEZAN MARU NO.2" and "YUGAO MARU" have been sold to your goodselves and that you do not wish to maintain their classification in the Society's Register Book.

The Committee have had the cases before them at their meeting today and I am directed to say that, in the circumstances, they have given instructions for the characters of these two ships to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of these vessels' classes the records of the freeboards assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draughts, will also be withdrawn and the freeboard certificates are thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
