These pipes were cut from one length of solid drawn
^{pipe} copper, flanges brazed on, and annealed and tested by hydraulic
pressure to four hundred pounds per square inch and a sample piece
cut from pipe, was flattened till sides met, both tests were
satisfactory.

The pipes have been sent to Grimsby.

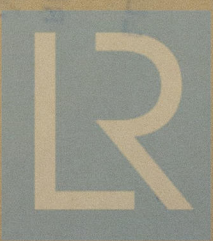
