The Modified Survey of this vessel's Oil Engines became due in January last, and the Donkey Boiler Survey, due 1,31, which has been held with the exception of the adjustment of the safety valves, again became due in January last.

The vessel has been laid up at Stockholm since March, 1931.

On the 14th April last the Stockholm Surveyors intimated that the ship had been sold to the present Owners, and on enquiry of the Society's Surveyors at Havre they now forward a letter from the new Owners in which they state that she has been classed with the Bureau Veritas.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Friday, 27th ultimo, when in the circumstances they decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
