
We wish to acknowledge receipt of your letter regarding the above steamer and we note your remarks concerning same.

We would inform you that we did not attempt to move this vessel without consulting your representative. The writer was at Fowey and came round with the vessel. We acquainted your representative at Plymouth with the fact that the vessel was about to proceed from Fowey to South Stockton to break up and asked if it was necessary for him to proceed to Fowey and inspect the vessel before she proceeded, his reply was that he would have to get in touch with his principals, this he apparently did for he informed us that it was not necessary for him to survey the vessel. We naturally saw that everything was in order before leaving having regard to the vessel's making the passage in ballast under the weather conditions we get in the North Sea.
