Dear Sirs, The Third Special Survey No. 1, 1932, on this vessel: I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Cardiff have forwarded to this Office your letter of the 13th instant, addressed to them, respecting your steamer "IVYTOWN". Applicable since the beginning of March 1932.

The case has been submitted to the Committee at their meeting today and I am directed to say that, in view of your intimation, they have given instructions for this vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
