

Steam Trawler "JENWIL"

The Milford Haven Surveyor was recently authorised to carry out the 2nd S.S.No.3 of this vessel, but in view of its importance he was informed that he should be joined by Mr. Cheetham, or a Senior Surveyor from Cardiff.

A letter has now been received from the Milford Surveyor stating that the survey was commenced at the beginning of this week, and it appears that the greater part has been held. A question has arisen between the Surveyor and the Manager of the vessel regarding the examination of the framing behind a fresh water tank (of 20 tons capacity) on the starboard side - the Surveyor desiring this to be removed for the purpose, and the Manager objecting to this being done. When the Surveyor asked a second time for this tank to be removed the Manager told him not to do anything further in the matter, as he intended taking ~~the vessel~~ ^{the vessel} out of class, owing to the fact that she had been working at a loss for some time.

As the Owner of this vessel is resident at Milford Haven it is submitted Mr. Cheetham should be furnished with the correspondence and requested to call upon him at Milford Haven as soon as possible, with a view to discussing the difference of opinion which has arisen and endeavouring to come to some arrangement to permit of the retention of the class. At the same time he should join the local surveyor in the survey.
