

4s. 8d. A TON STEAMER

The lowest price ever paid for a steamer in the history of the South Wales shipping trade was given by Mr. A. Levy, of London, who at Cardiff yesterday bought the Marchioness of Bute, a vessel of 7,270 tons deadweight, for £1,700—4s. 8d. a ton.

Mr. Levy bought the steamer from the Redcroft Steam Navigation Co., the managing owners being Sir Lewis Lougher and Co. The Marchioness of Bute was built in 1906 and has been laid up at Bideford for two years.
